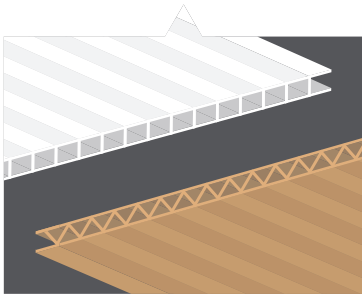




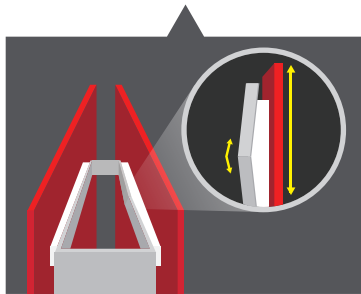

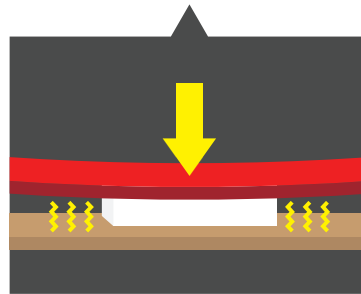
Consider Your Surfaces

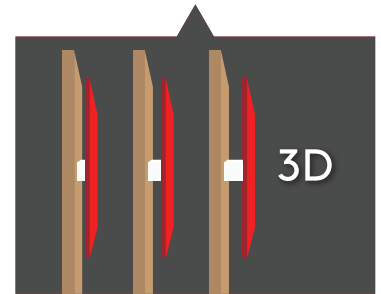
Length

Long bond lines might cause flex or warp creating immediate stress on the bond and indicate the need of a foam tape.
